WORKSHEET INSTRUCTIONS

SECTION 1

Minimum Income is determined by the total number of dependents in your household. Page 1 of your 2019 Federal Tax Return will be required for this section.

SECTION 2

Household Income is the total income from all sources for your household. Page 2 of your 2019 Federal Tax Return will be required for this section.

SECTION 3

Maximum Income is the maximum allowed for a family like you. 2020-21 grade levels for your students and Dependent information will be required for this section.

SECTION 4

Final Summary Using the final lines from Sections 1 through 3, a summary showing status if you qualify. You will still need to complete FACTS once approved by GCE.

(SVdP Cost for 1 Student is \$6,190*, Cost for 2 Students is \$11,223*, Cost for 3 or more students is \$14,523*)

Cost to Attend Ozark Catholic Academy in 2020-21 _____

(OCA Cost is \$15,602* per student)

Add All 3 Lines Together – **MAXIMUM INCOME** _____

*We believe the total cost to attend Catholic school is more than just tuition. We take into consideration all required Fees and State, Federal, and Payroll taxes that can be incurred on your income to determine a Net Cost to you. This method of calculation gives a number higher than published tuition.

SECTION 4 – FINAL SUMMARY

Does your **HOUSEHOLD INCOME** (Section 2) fall between **MINIMUM INCOME** (Section 1) and **MAXIMUM INCOME** (Section 3)? If **YES**, you qualify for financial aid from GCE.
